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Dear Parent/Carer,

As you are aware school is being asked to partially open for selected year groups; vulnerable children and key worker children. Guidance has been produced and we will be taking relevant measures to keep both pupils and staff safe and reducing risks. There are some measures that you will need to take.

Firstly, anyone showing symptoms of Coronavirus should not be in school and should self-isolate for 7 days from the start of symptoms. If anyone in your household shows symptoms you should self-isolate for 14 days unless you start to show symptoms. In which case you should self-isolate for 7 days from the start of your symptoms. Key workers may get a test for themselves or members of their household showing symptoms. This is also applicable for households with children in reception, year 1 and year 6 now. If they are negative for coronavirus they will be able to return to school.

- Please can parents not enter the school building unless absolutely necessary.
- Please keep socially distanced on the playground when dropping off and picking up.
- Send your child in through the relevant entrance.
  - Year R – Class 1 door
  - Year 1 – the door from the front playground
  - Year 6 – Mobile Classroom door
  - Keyworker children and vulnerable children not in the above year groups - the door from the front playground
- All monies should be sent in a sealed, named envelope detailing its purpose e.g. lunch money
- Please collect your child from the place you dropped them off.
- Please ensure your child has some tissues to use in school in their pocket.
- You may send your child with hand sanitiser and moisturiser for their personal use if you wish.
- Older children should make their own way to school from home or an agreed place in the village.

School food services will be supplying lunches as normal. Please indicate lunch arrangements of the form.

Should I deem that there are unsafe staff levels due to illness and self-isolation, I may need to close the school to year groups or all children. Please listen to Radio Leicester or check our website daily to ensure school is open. (This would only be in extreme circumstances.)

We understand some parents may feel unsafe sending their child to school please indicate on the attached slip if you will not be sending your child to school. We can only take keyworker children and those of the indicated year groups if we are to be able to have any social distancing in school.
