

SCHOOL DINNERS

The School Food Support Service who provides our meals in school has a new menu starting in the autumn term 2019. Parents will be given a copy of this as soon as it is available. In the meantime, the current menu is enclosed.

School dinners are served every day in the School Hall at 12 noon. For pupils in years 3-6 the cost of a school dinner is £2.25 per day (£11.25 per week). Payment is due on Monday morning for the week and can be made by cash or a cheque payable to Leicestershire County Council. It is possible for your child to have dinners on specific days of the week, but we do request that these days are the same days each week.

Parents in receipt of a range of benefits are encouraged to claim for meanstested free school meals and this will, of course, remain confidential. Pupils are also entitled to a one-third carton of milk each day upon request. The school receives its funding based on the number of pupils claiming (though not necessarily taking) these free school meals, so it is advantageous to the school and therefore your child if you claim when you are entitled to it. Your child will also not need to pay any contribution to trips and visits whilst claiming (meanstested) free school meals as the governors will fund this.
