UNIFORM

We believe that the school uniform at Thurlaston School gives the children a sense of belonging and helps to develop self-discipline. We encourage them to be clean and smart at all times.

It is important that all clothing and personal possessions are clearly marked with the owner's full name.

The uniform consists of:

Key Stage 1:

- Pale blue polo shirt
- Navy blue sweatshirt or cardigan
- Grey or navy shorts/trousers, that are smart
- Grey or navy pinafore dress or skirt
- Short or knee length socks or tights in navy, white or grey
- Black school shoes or smart black flat ankle boots
- During warmer weather children may wear a blue gingham school dress
- Weather appropriate coat

Key Stage 2:

- Pale blue shirt with school tie
- Navy blue sweatshirt or cardigan
- Grey or navy shorts/trousers that are smart
- Grey or navy pinafore dress or skirt
- Short or knee length socks or tights in navy, white or grey
- Black school shoes or smart black flat ankle boots
- During warmer weather children may wear a blue gingham school dress
- Weather appropriate coat

Ties can be purchased from the school office.

PE Kit:

- Navy or black shorts
- White t-shirt
- Plain black or white trainers or black plimsolls
- Navy or black joggers may be worn for outdoor PE only, due to health and safety

All PE Kit should be left at school during the week.

This should be kept in a small bag with the child's name clearly marked.

Jewellery:

For health and safety reasons we do not allow children to wear jewellery to school.

Exceptions are made for:

- Wrist watches, not smart watches
- Small stud earrings
- Small objects of religious significance or medical necessity

We do ask the children to remove jewellery during PE, games, and swimming to avoid potential injury. A small box will need to be provided for their belongings and will be their own responsibility.

If children are unable to remove their jewellery they will need to provide tape to cover.

For any new piercings, please consider having these done at the start of the summer holidays to allow for healing.

We would be grateful if you could ensure that your child does NOT wear the following:

- Sports shirts
- Hoodies
- Leggings, jeans or cords
- Shoes/boots with heels or Uggs
- Trainers (unless for PE)
- Heelys, trainers with wheels in the base
- Flip flops, sandals, beach shoes or mules
- Branded items are not encouraged
